This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

The petitioners Smt. Smita Adhikari and Ayushi Adhikari are present in Court and they have been identified by their counsel Mr. Nilambar Nayak.

In the first hour, when the matter was taken up, it was found out that as per the impugned order, the petitioners are entitled to get Rs.56,000/- (rupees fifty six thousand) from the opposite party towards their maintenance.

Learned counsel for the opposite party was asked to contact with the opposite party for depositing such amount in the bank account of petitioner no.1 Smt. Smita Adhikari.

The matter was taken up at 1.10 p.m. and the learned counsel for the opposite party submitted that

in the meantime, a sum of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) has already been deposited by the opposite party in the bank account of petitioner no.1 Smt. Smita Adhikari after she furnished the details of the account and he is ready to pay the balance amount of Rs.6,000/- (rupees six thousand) to petitioner no.1 in Court today.

Petitioner no.1 Smt. Smita Adhikari submits that she has verified that Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) has already come to her account.

Learned counsel for the opposite party handed over Rs.6,000/- (rupees six thousand) to petitioner no.1 Smt. Smita Adhikari in Court, she has verified and found to be correct.

In view of the fact that the opposite party has already deposited the amount in question, the Inspector in-charge of Mohana police station shall not cause his production in Court as per the order dated 18.08.2023.

The matter be listed in the week commencing from 11.09.2023.
